NEW LIVING WELL DISEASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS -

Including how to receive certain free benefits for those with diabetes or a cardiac condition

New Wellness/Lifestyle and Disease Management Programs

All members and spouses in the Active Plans and all Non-Medicare age members and spouses in the Retiree Plan who have been diagnosed with diabetes or a cardiac condition or are at risk for diabetes or a cardiac condition are eligible to enroll for free in a Disease Management Program administered by the MCM Living Well Program.

The Programs include:

- Diabetes Management
- Cardiac (Heart) Health

Participants who enroll in the Diabetes Management Program will receive:

- Free glucose monitor and free test strips with NO copay NO deductible!
- Medically necessary diabetic oral medications and Insulin with NO copy NO deductible!
- Medically necessary diabetic supplies with NO copay NO deductible!
- Two annual consultations with a Board-Certified Endocrinologist.
- Free annual eye exam, quarterly A1C lab tests and lipid profiles.

Participants who enroll in the Cardiac (Heart) Management Program will receive:

- Free medically necessary Generic cardiovascular prescriptions.
- Two annual consultations with a Board-Certified Cardiologist.
- Medically necessary routine EKG, blood chemistry and lipid profiles with NO copay and NO deductible!

To enroll in one of the Disease Management Programs, call the Med-Care Management Living Well Program at 866-844-4222 and a nurse health coach will assist you and answer any questions.

Once enrolled in the MCM Living Well Programs, you will have your own nurse health coach who will help you better manage your diabetes or cardiac condition. The nurse will be available to answer your questions and help you meet your health goals. All information is kept confidential.
